

Policy NSDO-P04: Terms of Reference for Committee PP-20

Environmental Performance of Building Products in Australia

1. Introduction

Committee PP-20 is responsible for the development and content of the ecolabelling and environmental declaration standards for building products and services that have an impact on environment and sustainability.

2. Responsibilities

The prime responsibilities of Committee PP-20 are to:

- develop ecolabelling and environmental declaration standards for products and services that has an impact on environment and sustainability
- consult widely with major stakeholders and interested parties in the industry on the development of ecolabelling and environmental declaration standards
- ensure consistent applications of and compliance with ecolabelling and environmental declaration standards in industry
- review existing standards to ensure that there is no duplication and/or conflict
- where potential duplication and/or conflict arises, work in collaboration with other standard development organisations to attain an amiable resolution to the duplication and/or conflict
- promote and assist the understanding and implementation of standards
- recommend to the NSDO Board the approval and publication of developed standards; and
- ensure that the Committee is representative and balanced.
